


With Google Home you can now add your Adax Wi-Fi heater to your Google Assistant




## Follow the few installation steps below to add your heater(s) to Google Assistant.

Remember to have your Adax Account details ready for a quick installation.










Connect your device (s) to a "home" or "room"

# Google Assistant commands for controlling Thermostats

A list of voice commands for controlling thermostats in your Smart Home with Google Assistant

**To set the temperature to all thermostats** "Hey Google, set the temperature to 22."

**To set thermostat using the thermostat's room name** "Hey Google, set the <room> thermostat to 22."

**To set thermostat using the thermostat's name** "Hey Google, set <thermostat> to 20°C."

**To hear the ambient temperature on the thermostat** "Hey Google, what's the <room> temperature inside?"

To hear what the temperature is set to on the thermostat "Hey Google, what's the <room> thermostat set to?"

Increase/Decrease the temperature on all thermostats "Hey Google, make it warmer/cooler." (Google Assistant for 3 degrees)

Increase/Decrease the temperature using the thermostat's room name "Hey Google, raise/lower the temperature in the <room>."

Increase/Decrease the temperature using the thermostat's name "Hey Google, raise/lower the temperature of <thermostat>."



## Increase/Decrease the temperature in all rooms for X degrees

"Hey Google, raise/lower the temperature by 2 degrees."

Increase/Decrease the temperature of thermostat for X degrees "Hey Google, raise/lower the temperature of <thermostat> by 2 degrees."

## To switch heating or cooling for all rooms modes<sup>1</sup>

"Hey Google, turn on the heating/cooling." "Hey Google, turn on the heat."

### To switch heating or cooling for a specific room/thermostat<sup>1</sup>

"Hey Google, set <thermostat> to heating/cooling/automatic." "Hey Google, turn the <thermostat> to heat/cool/automatic (mode)." "Hey Google, make it warmer/cooler in the <room>" - Sets a heating or cooling mode
